In 2006, an ancient Egyptian statue of the queen Nefertiti was electronically scanned, revealing that _____ (A) _____. Based on prior research, experts were already aware that the bust consisted of a limestone core covered in stucco. They assumed that the sculptor had used the core as a mere scaffold for the stucco layers, which had been carefully shaped to depict the queen. Thanks to the 3D scans, the researchers were able to put this assumption to the test. They found that the core was not simply a mold to support the stucco layers but was actually a skillful sculpture in its own right. Although the representation is not as finely crafted as the one that is visible to the naked eye, it still contains impressive details, including creases around Nefertiti's mouth and a small bump on her nose.

Questions 33-36 are based on the following passage.

In 1963, US Navy pilot Eugene Cernan was selected by NASA to join Astronaut Group 3, the third group of astronauts to take part in the Gemini and Apollo space missions. He was able to apply to the program thanks to recent changes to NASA regulations. These changes made pilots with military jet fighter aircraft experience eligible to serve, whereas formerly only those with test pilot backgrounds were deemed qualified. Due to his **immaculate** record with the US Navy, Cernan was encouraged to apply to the program, and NASA eventually chose him as one of the 14 members of the select group.

During his 13 years in the space program, Cernan made many notable contributions. He served as a crew member or a backup crew member on a total of six missions. He made a total of three trips into space, including participating in two lunar missions, the earliest being a mission to orbit the moon in preparation for the first moon landing, which took place two months later.

However, Cernan is perhaps most widely remembered today as the _____ (A) _____. As part of the Apollo 17 mission, Cernan and another astronaut, Harrison Schmitt, descended to the moon's surface in a lunar module named *Challenger*. There, they jointly conducted three moonwalks, during which they collected geological samples. When they returned to the lunar module, Schmitt was the first to ascend the stairs, leaving Cernan momentarily alone on the moon. As Apollo 17 was NASA's final landing mission, no one since Cernan has set foot on the moon's surface.
