(32-33) In 2022, Amazon could be held responsible for advertising 'fake' red-soled shoes which potentially breach designer Christian Louboutin's EU trademark. Similar red-soled high heels are advertised on Amazon by third party vendors without Louboutin's consent. The Court of Justice of the European Union (CJEU) said Amazon could be accountable for any trademark infringement. Louboutin said the platform's selling model was "misleading the public". Amazon says it will study the decision. The preliminary ruling by the CJEU clears the way for Amazon to potentially be held liable for adverts for any counterfeit products sold on its site. There has been a long-running dispute between Amazon and shoemaker Louboutin, whose high heels typically sell for at least \$600. Louboutin brought two cases against the company, in courts in Belgium and Luxembourg, in 2019 —alleging Amazon regularly displayed adverts for red-soled shoes on its marketplace without Louboutin's any consent.

(36-37) In 1900, the average life expectancy for Americans was less than fifty years. By the end of the century, that number was well over seventy years. In fact, since 1840, life expectancy in the United States has risen about three months with each passing year. And as average (A)_____ of life increased, so did average (B)_____. While people often face a period of very poor health before dying, that span has shrunk, due mostly to medical advances. In the words of Harvard University Professor David Cutler, "Where we used to see people who are very, very sick for the final six or seven years of their lives, that's now far less common. People are living to older ages and we are adding healthy years, not debilitated ones."

But all this must be taken in balance. Although average quality of life has increased, the short span before death can be a harrowing period for many of society's most elderly—a time when quality of life, actually, is at its worst. In 2011, a National Institute of Aging study estimated that 25-30 percent of people aged 85 or older suffered from dementia. The authors further commented that dementia prevalence is expected to rise dramatically with the aging of the population worldwide.

The pandemic created incredible stress to the social safety net. Among its many impacts was an enormous and almost immediate explosion of food need necessitating a community and government response unmatched in our lifetimes. Pandemic response programs like the child tax reduction and universal school breakfasts and lunches not only stemmed the tide, they effectively cut child poverty in half and enabled measurable declines in food insecurity.

These programs were allowed to expire this past spring just as inflation began propelling prices to rise. Families that had gotten back on their feet lost the ground they'd gained. In our region alone, more than 1 million people will turn to a neighborhood food bank or meal provider for the food they need to sustain themselves this year. The sharp increase in demand has mirrored peak pandemic levels and caused such significant and urgent food need that inventory levels in our warehouse were drawn down 75% by late summer. To ensure people facing hunger have access to the food they need today, we are rebuilding our inventory by dramatically expanding food sourcing.
